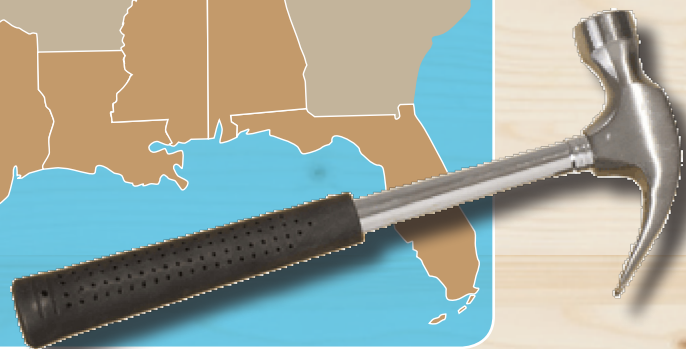
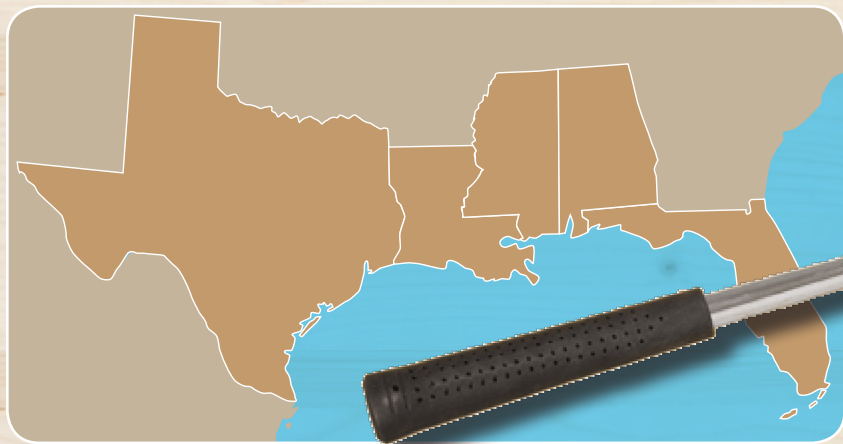


HOMEOWNER'S HANDBOOK TO PREPARE FOR NATURAL HAZARDS

Numerous state and federal agencies, as well as private companies, will work together to create the handbook, which will present the information in a comprehensive and easy-to-read format.

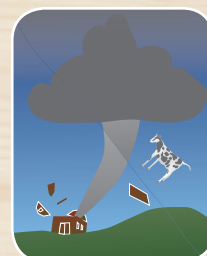
The handbook will be distributed and will be available for download.
