

Gulf of Mexico Alliance: Environmental Education Grant Recipients 2010

The Dauphin Island Sea Lab (DISL), on behalf of the State of Alabama Department of Conservation and Natural Resources Coastal Section, wrote and successfully received a grant from the National Oceanic and Atmospheric Administration's Coastal Services Center (NOAA CSC) for environmental education with the Gulf of Mexico Alliance (GOMA). This grant allows funding for Gulf-wide environmental education. Funding, if reappropriated, allows for three years of projects; these projects represent year two of the cycle. \$40,000 was awarded to each of the five Gulf States and distributed to the following organizations:
